
WHAT IS THE STATE OF COALITION

STABILITY DOESN'T ALWAYS MEAN GOOD PERFORMANCE OR FULFILLING SERVICE MANDATES. BUT COALITION TRICKS OFTEN WORSEN EXISTING CHALLENGES.

FORMAL COALITION AGREEMENTS ARE FEW AND FAR BETWEEN AND MOST ARE ABOUT POSITIONS AND PORTFOLIOS, NOT POLICY. AGREEMENTS ARE ALSO ABOUT HOW TO VOTE IN COUNCILS AND APPLYING TACTICS LIKE WALK-OUTS.





PARTIES CAN SWITCH ALLEGIANCE AND CHANGE COALITION PARTNERS AT A WHIM. THIS IS BAD FOR ACCOUNTABILITY TO THEIR CONSTITUENCIES AND THE ELECTORATE.



SOME PARTIES HAVE LEARNED TO PLAY THE GAME AND STRIKE AGREEMENTS WITH ONE BLOC, ONLY TO SWITCH TO ANOTHER COALITION LATER.






INSTRUMENTS TO TAKE POWER, NOT TO FIX
GOVERNANCE FAILURES. THESE ARE OFTEN
TABLED ON FRIVOLOUS GROUNDS. JUST ABOUT
ANYTHING REASON CAN BE FOUND TO TRIGGER A
MOTION-OF-NO-CONFIDENCE.





SOME CLLRS HAVE MASTERED THE COALITIONS GAME. THEY BREAK RANKS WITH THEIR PARTIES IN COUNCIL VOTES, DEFECT, FORCE BY-ELECTIONS AND SOMETIMES WIN FOR A NEW PARTY.





CHALLENGES FACING COALITION
GOVERNMENTS ALSO HAUNT MAJORITY
COUNCILS - DEBT, LIMITED RESOURCES,
LOW INCOME BASE, SKILLS AND
CAPACITY ISSUES AS WELL AS POOR AND
DECLINING INFRASTRUCTURE.
